DSC's Residential Services offers an array of community-based residential alternatives to promote independence.

The Apartment Services Program (ASP) supports individuals living in the community in independent apartments.

Support varies for each person, as their individual needs are considered and addressed.

An "After-Hours" paging service is also included for additional confidence and support.



## C-U Independence Apartments

---

DSC operates and maintains C-U Independence Apartments. This 24 unit building is secured and has evening staff support available when needed.

C-U Independence Apartments and Prairie Homes, Inc., which supports DSC's mission, comply with Affirmative Fair Housing regulations and Section 504 and ADA regulations.

Rental assistance is provided to very low-income applicants.

## FAQ's

### Who may be served?

- Any Champaign County resident with a developmental disability, who meets the eligibility requirements of this specific program

### Is there a fee?

- Participants in the Apartment Services Program are responsible for paying rent established by the landlord.
- C-U Independence is a HUD-subsidized project, so rent is determined accordingly.
