and services 24 hours a day, 365 days a
year to eight or fewer adults in a
family style setting.

Individuals living in a CILA enjoy ongoing recreational, social and community integration opportunities, matching their preferences and interests.

DSC has CILA's located in Champaign, Urbana and Rantoul.

Residential Services

DSC's Residential Services offer an array of community-based residential alternatives to promote independence.

Services are based upon an individual's preferences and needs. Programs vary in the level of supervision, structure, and support provided.

DSC also offers service facilitation for the Home Based Support Waiver to individuals who receives this funding.





Apartment Services

The Apartment Services Program (ASP) provides supports and services to individuals developing and maintaining skills necessary to live independently in their community.

DSC also operates and maintains C-U Independence Apartments; a 24-unit supported apartment building, ensuring independence and safety.

Intermittent support, provided by an Apartment Services Case Manager, offers up to 15 hours of services per week in the Apartment Services Program.

Respite Services

Respite service provides temporary relief to families from the care of a loved one with a developmental disability who is living at home. This service allows family members to enjoy a long weekend, address the needs of other family members or to just take a break. Each family considers how the limited respite hours can be most beneficial to their family and hires their own provider.

Any child or adult with a developmental disability who resides in the family home and lives in Champaign or Ford County is eligible for services as resources allow.
