The ASQ can provide a quick snapshot of a child's overall behavior and development. This will assist with identifying children who may need further evaluation, and/or determine the existence of a delay or disability, and eligibility of services for the child.

Finally, the ASQ identifies a child's strengths and needs across all areas of development, which can be useful information for the child's caretakers. DSC's Developmental Screener can assist the family with linkage and referral to appropriate services.
