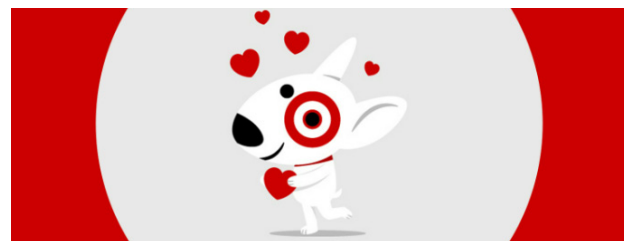
## Community Day Services Receives Grant
